OUR FUNDRAISING EFFORTS 2023-24

The Foundation hosts many different fundraising events annually that help to provide funding for Foundation programs. An equal amount of both inschool and external school fundraising events are planned throughout the year. Below is a breakdown of fundraising events that we've held thus far in the 2023-24 school year:

SOS Merchandise Sales - \$335.73 SOS Dress Down - \$27,115.46 Restaurant Fundraiser - \$2,437.36 Miami Heat Fundraiser - \$3,584

PPCSF FL Prepaid Raffle #1 (Net Income) - \$9,052.97

FY 2022-23 Total Proceeds

As a whole, the Foundation raised a total of \$314,778.72.

The Foundation collectively raised \$314,778.72 in the 2022-23 school year. Working in collaboration with the City's Recreation Department, we generated \$135,657.70 from sponsorships and live auction proceeds during the 2022-23 Mayor's Golf Tournament.

Another event hosted by the City's Recreation Department was the 2022-23 'Taste Of Pines' Event, from which we earned \$16,229.68 in ticket proceeds. We are excited to continue our partnership with the City's Recreation Department this year for additional events that will further support and benefit the Pembroke Pines Charter School Foundation.
