The Foundation hosts many different fundraising events annually that help to provide funding for Foundation programs. An equal amount of both in-school and external school fundraising events are planned throughout the year. - PPCSF FL Prepaid Raffle #2 (Net Income)** - TBD

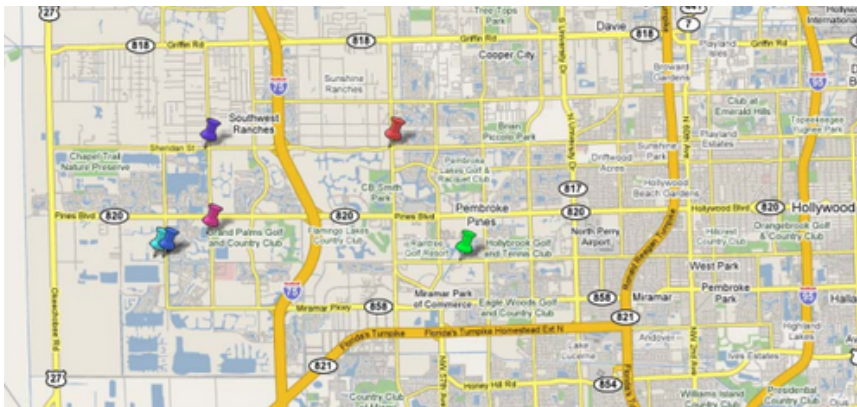

FY 2023-24 Total Proceeds

As a whole, the Foundation raised a total of **\$279,377.94**.

Through partnering with the City's Recreation Department, we raised a total of \$70,275.23 from Sponsorships and Live Auction Proceeds for the 2023-24 Mayor's Golf Tournament.

Another event held by the City's Recreation Department was the 2023-24 'Taste Of Pines' Event thru which we raised \$18,222.71 in Ticket Proceeds.
